The Vancouver Island Paleontological Society, charter member of The British Columbia Paleontological Alliance and North Island College are pleased to host the Seventh British Columbia Paleontological Symposium, at Courtenay North Island College campus, May 18-21, 2007. An exciting variety of activities will include abstract presentations, poster displays, paleo-workshops, paleo-art show, and field trips. Scheduling will facilitate attendee's participation in all events.

We are very fortunate to present as the keynote speaker, Dr. Ryosuke Motani, Assistant Professor in Department of Geology at University of California and recent recipient of the Gakujutsu Prize from the Paleontological Society of Japan for his studies on extinct marine reptiles, specifically with ichthyosaurs.

Registration fees for the Symposium are \$100 + GST for professional paleontologists and non - BCPA members, \$85 + GST for BCPA members and \$60 for students. This fee will include all activities including the welcoming reception on May 18th and Banquet on May 19th, but not the field trips or workshops.
